

Debt Collection Communications Log of

How to Document Debt Collection Communications:

1. Keep this Log next to your phone for quick access.
2. Identify the alleged debt for which you are receiving demands in the space provided below.
3. Make detailed notes in the table below for every phone call, voicemail, message, letter or other event relating to this alleged debt.
4. Record every phone call with any debt collector regarding this debt by use of a recording device if you have one available.
5. Save and record to an external device every phone message that you receive from any debt collector regarding this alleged debt.
6. Keep every letter, including the envelope, for every piece of mail you receive—and copies of your own letters—regarding this alleged debt.
7. Be sure to document in your notes any of the following:
 - a. threats of violence or harm;
 - b. obscene or profane language;
 - c. false or misleading statements like implying that they're attorneys or government representatives when they're not;
 - d. falsely implying that you've committed a crime;
 - e. falsely representing that they operate or work for a credit bureau;
 - f. misrepresenting the amount of the debt;
 - g. indicating that papers being sent to you are legal forms when in fact they are not;
 - h. indicating the papers being sent to you are not legal forms when in fact they are;
 - i. threats of arrest if you do not pay the debt;
 - j. threats of seizure, garnishment, attachment or selling your property or wages unless they truly intend to do so and they have a legal right to do so;
 - k. threats of a lawsuit against you if you do not pay when they have no legal right to sue you or they really do not intend to do so;
 - l. contacting you by postcard;
 - m. telling your employer, neighbors or anyone else other than your spouse about their claim of the alleged debt against you;
 - n. use of some decent bit of act make you accept a collect call or paper telegrams from the debt collector.
